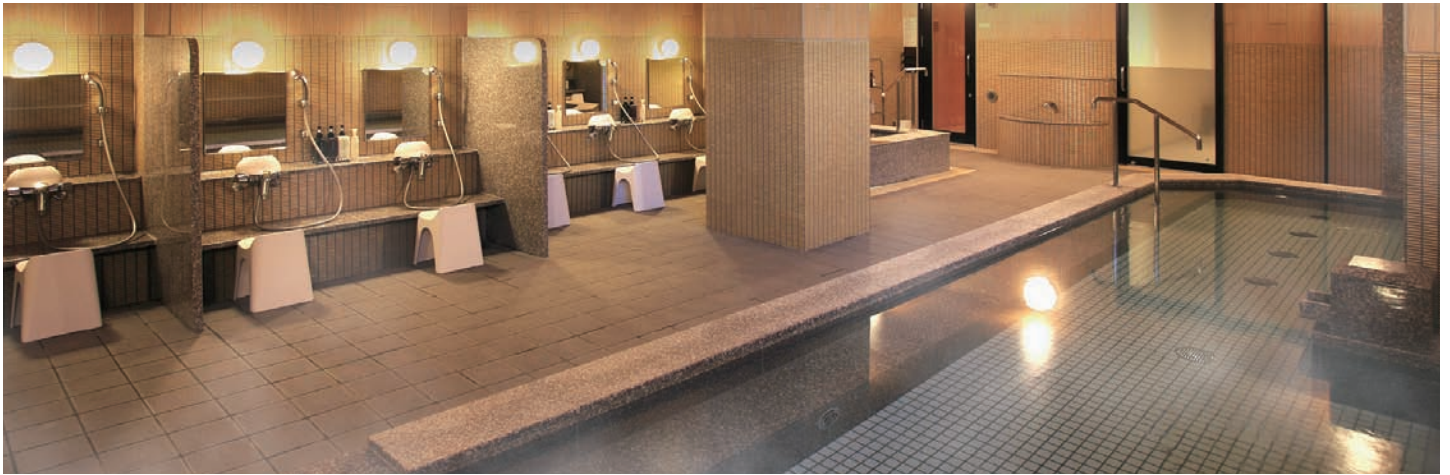


Japanese Spa



Usage Guide

Hours of operation 5 PM to 1AM./Location New Building 2F.

Please take the bath towel and face towel provided in your room with you to the public bath.

Please also use the samue(nightwear)and slippers provided.

You will need your room key in order to access the baths.

(Additionally, for ladies a password is required)

Caution



The Public Bath is for our guests only.



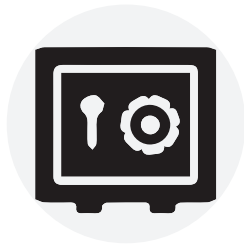
The dressing room and bathroom are slippery. Please watch your step.



Please lock the locker and make sure to carry the key with you.



If the key is lost, a fee is required.



Please use the security box in the room for your valuable belongings. Please note that the hotel is not responsible for any loss or theft in the public bath.



Guests who have skin diseases please refrain from using the public bath.



Children should be accompanied by adults.



Children under 6 years old can use both male and female public baths.



Prohibited in the public bath



Guests who have tattoos (including tattoo stickers) please refrain from using the public bath.



People who are drunk are not permitted to enter.



Smoking is prohibited in the public bath.



Do not use mobile phones, smartphones, or tablets or take pictures in the locker room or bathhouse.



Please refrain from taking away amenities from the public bath.



Guests who have infectious diseases should not use the public bath.



Do not use the sauna or bath if you are not feeling well.



Do not make a loud voice in the bathhouse or spit in the bathtub or in the aisle to the sauna.



Wipe your body well in the bathhouse and go to the locker room.



Do not sleep in the aisle or in the sauna.



Do not wear a bathing suit.



Rinse your body with hot water or a shower before bathing.



Do not splash hot water unnecessarily in the washing place or swim in the bathtub.



Do not put hair or towel into the bathtub.



Do not do the washing or dye your hair in the bathtub.

It is prohibited to bring the following items



Animals (including your pets)



Goods which have a bad or characteristic odor



Dangerous goods such as explosives, guns, knives



A significantly large number of goods Or any goods that may disturb other guests.



Please refrain from bringing food into the public bath.
